Antisocial Personality Disorder

13.5.2.1. Antisocial personality disorder. Treatment options for antisocial personality disorder are limited and generally not effective (Black, 2015). Like Cluster A disorders, many individuals are forced to participate in treatment, thus impacting their ability to engage in and continue with treatment. Cognitive therapists have attempted to address the lack of morality and encourage patients to think about the needs of others (Beck & Weishaar, 2011) (Bridley & Daffin, 2022).

Narcissistic Personality Disorder

13.5.2.4. Narcissistic personality disorder. Of all the personality disorders, narcissistic personality disorder is among the most difficult to treat (with maybe the exception of antisocial personality disorder). Most individuals with narcissistic personality disorder only seek out treatment for those disorders secondary to their personality disorder, such as depression (APA, 2022). The focus of treatment is to address the grandiose, self-centered thinking, while also trying to teach patients how to empathize with others (Beck & Weishaar, 2014) (Bridley & Daffin, 2022).

Bernadetta's Treatment Plan

There is no effective communication for narcissistic personality disorder. Accountability, and therapeutic session may help the person deal with the disorder in a positive aspect.

1. Ignoring right and wrong.
2. Telling lies to take advantage of others.
3. Not being sensitive to or respectful of others.
4. Using charm or wit to manipulate others for personal gain or pleasure.
5. Having a sense of superiority and being extremely opinionated.
6. Having problems with the law, including criminal behavior.
7. Being hostile, aggressive, violent or threatening to others.
8. Feeling no guilt about harming others.
9. Doing dangerous things with no regard for the safety of self or others.
10. Being irresponsible and failing to fulfill work or financial responsibilities.

Adults with antisocial personality disorder usually show symptoms of conduct disorder before the age of 15. ~~Symptoms of conduct disorder include serious, ongoing behavior problems, such as:~~

1. Aggression toward people and animals. Lying and dishonesty.
2. Theft.
3. Serious violations of rules.
4. Destruction of property.
